2020 FIRE PREVENTION POSTER CONTEST

Serve Up Fire Safety In The Kitchen!

Pre-K through 6th grade students are invited to participate in a contest honoring **National Fire Prevention Week** (October 4–10, 2020.) There are **two** chances to win prizes! Students may enter the Poster Contest, the Home Escape Plan Challenge, or both! The 2020 Fire Prevention Week theme is: *Serve Up Fire Safety In The Kitchen!*

Part 1 Poster/Video Contest

1. Student's name, school, grade and teacher's email must be included in submission.
2. Students may submit a 1-3 minute video promoting the safety theme of this year or a poster drawn on a 8 1/2 x by 11 letter sized paper. Videos should not include live fire or unsafe scenarios.
3. Posters and videos should promote the Fire Prevention Week theme, and encourage fire safety awareness in the home, school and community.
4. One (1) entry per student.
5. Drawings are to be completed by students, without assistance. Videos may have filming assistance and no editing assistance.
6. Only hand drawn entries for posters will be accepted (no computer-generated images). Videos must be done by a student and not professional.
7. A panel of judges will select the winning posters based on originality, clarity of message, design and age-appropriate skill. The decision of the judges is final.

- The poster, video and worksheet submission deadline is **October 30, 2020**. The winning posters/videos from each grade will be judged by fire service personnel and hospital staff.
- The winners will be notified by **November 13, 2020**.
- Three winners (1st, 2nd and 3rd place) will be chosen from each grade level. One grand prize winner for the Poster/Video Contest, and one for the Home Escape Plan Challenge will receive –\$100 for their school or group and a pizza party for their family.
- The winning poster/video will be used in promotional material where appropriate. All winners will be honored at a virtual awards ceremony on Friday, November 20, 2020 at 5:30pm.
